

Supply List for Oil Painting

To bring to class first night (can be purchased at Utrechts or Plaza Arts). Students should feel free to determine the brand based on pricing.

- Oil paints: titanium white, black, cadmium red, lemon yellow, cobalt or ultramarine blue – small tubes are fine
- Liquin-oil paint medium (other oil paint mediums are optional)
- Variety of different size oil painting brushes-small, med., large widths-pointed and flat, squared and rounded tips, make sure they're long handled
- Palette-wood or wax paper or flat plastic-don't get buy a palette with concave cups
- Palette knife for mixing paint
- Turpentine or paint thinner-odorless
- Gentle, liquid dishwashing soap
- Container to put turpentine or paint thinner in with lid (glass jar is best) extra cup or bowl to put it in while working
- Container to put palette with paint in (Tupperware) or alum foil to cover palette (to keep paints wet)
- Papertowels/rags
- Box/bag to put it all in!
- Stretched canvas min. size 11x14"
