

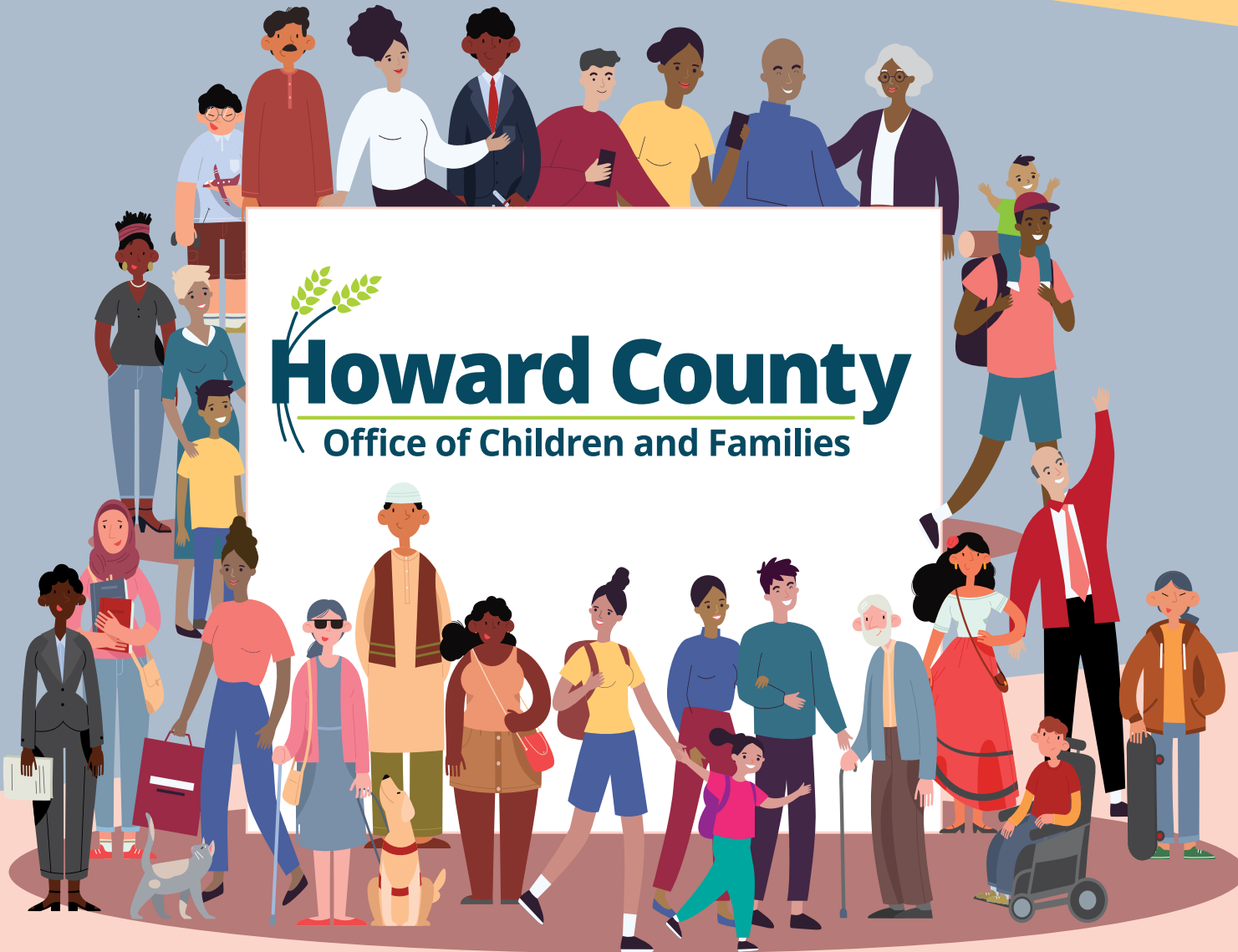

Welcome to the 2024 edition of the Howard County Parents' Guide.

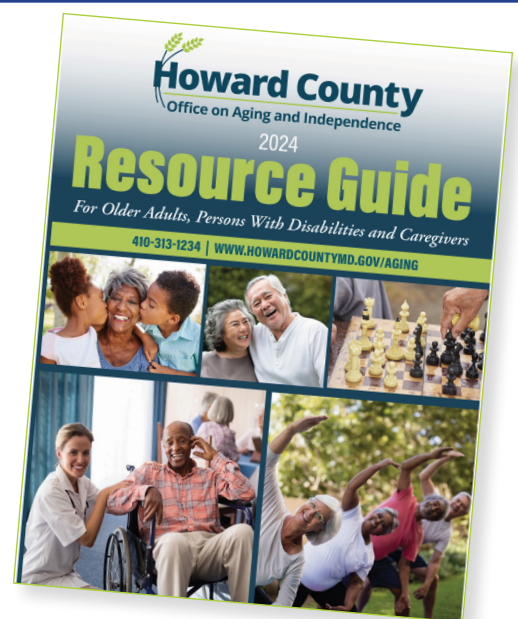
