Howard County's Department of Public Works (DPW) will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, September 12 from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. in the Lisbon Elementary School cafeteria, located at 15901 Frederick Road in Woodbine, to discuss the study, design and planned stabilization of a failing slope north of Watersville Road near the CSX railroad crossing. The project will involve roadway reconstruction, construction of a storm drain inlet and manhole, and replacement of asphalt curb with concrete curb.

While there will be no formal presentation, the design plans will be available for public view and staff members will be on hand to explain the proposed work and detour, answer any questions and gather public comments.
