Police investigating collision involving motorcycle in Ellicott City

One transported to hospital with serious injuries

Howard County police are investigating a collision involving a motorcycle in Ellicott City that resulted in serious injuries.

At approximately 10:00 a.m., a 2007 Harley Davidson motorcycle was traveling northbound in the 6100 block of Meadowridge Road when a 2011 Chevy Silverado traveling southbound turned left in front of the motorcycle. The operator of the Harley laid his motorcycle down to avoid a collision with the truck, but sustained serious injuries. The investigation is ongoing.

The motorcycle operator, Eugene Alfred Shields, 46, of Ellicott City, was flown to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center.

The driver and sole-occupant of the pickup, Loren Douglas McDaniel, 62, of Baltimore, was not injured and remained at the scene.

Meadowridge Road was closed between Old Stockbridge Road and Route 100 for approximately two hours.
