Pedestrian struck this morning in Jessup dies

Howard County police are continuing to investigate a pedestrian collision that occurred this morning in Jessup. A 27-year-old Baltimore woman was taken to the hospital after being struck in the roadway and has died as a result of her injuries.

At approximately 4:47 a.m., a 2009 Dodge Ram was traveling westbound on Route 175, between Pocomoke Ave and Washington Blvd. (Rt. 1), when it struck a pedestrian attempting to cross Route 175.

The woman was transported to Howard County General Hospital, where she was pronounced dead. She will be identified after her family has been notified.

The driver of the Dodge Ram was not injured and has been identified as Raymond Slater, 61, of Glen Burnie.

Investigators believe preliminarily that pedestrian error contributed to the collision. No charges have been filed at this time.

All lanes of Route 175 have been reopened.
