Robbery

Elkridge, 21075: Lowe's, 8200 block of Gateway Overlook Drive, Mar. 29 8:49 p.m.

An adult male suspect stole a power tool from the business. As he was leaving, an employee confronted him in the parking lot and attempted to grab the tool. The suspect assaulted the employee and threatened him with a knife before fleeing. No serious injuries were reported. The investigation is ongoing.

SUSPECT: white male, no further description provided

A teenage victim reported he was walking in a residential area when he was approached by a juvenile acquaintance who displayed a pellet gun and threatened him. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.

An adult female victim reported that an adult male suspect approached her vehicle, displayed a handgun, and demanded her vehicle. The victim complied and the suspect fled in the victim's vehicle. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.
