## **Police investigating Laurel collision involving a pedestrian**

Howard County police are investigating a collision involving a pedestrian with serious injuries in Laurel.

At approximately 6:11 a.m., a 2014 Ford F-150 was traveling southbound on Washington Boulevard (Route 1) near Madison Avenue when it struck a pedestrian in the roadway. The pedestrian, David Charles Roy, 61, of Laurel, was transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center and is listed in serious but stable condition.

The driver, Elmer Lopez Landaverde, 36, of Pasadena, was not injured and remained on the scene.

Preliminarily, police believe that the pedestrian was crossing Route 1 wearing dark clothing and was not in a crosswalk at the time of the collision. The investigation is ongoing.
