Opioid overdose

Since the Wednesday, Nov. 22 daily crime bulletin, police have responded to one fatal and two non-fatal overdoses. In one of the non-fatal cases, Naloxone, also known as Narcan, was administered. Narcan is a medication that reverses the effect of an opioid overdose. In the other non-fatal overdose, the person was transported to the hospital for treatment.

2017 YTD Total Overdoses:

Fatal: 52*

Non-Fatal: 155

*In fatal cases, some deaths are pending autopsy results for opioids and/or other substances. Numbers may fluctuate.

Of the 155 non-fatal opioid overdoses, life-saving Narcan was administered in 140 incidents.
