Juveniles charged in three-day crime spree in Columbia

Howard County police have charged three juveniles with committing a series of crimes in Columbia over a three-day period last month.

One or more of the suspects, males age 15, of Baltimore; 14, of Columbia; and 11, of Columbia, have been charged in the following four cases:

In the 10300 block of Little Patuxent Parkway:

- June 16, Columbia Mall, golf cart stolen from the parking lot
- June 16, Central Library, library employee assaulted, suspects attempted to steal purse
- June 19, Columbia Mall, iPhone stolen from the Verizon store

In the 5400 block of Lynx Lane:

- June 19, Alta Wilde Lake, glass door broken, entry to apartment lobby attempted

Through investigation, officers identified the involved juveniles, who are facing various charges including assault, robbery, reckless endangerment, burglary, motor vehicle theft and theft.
