Robbery

Columbia, 21045: Route 29 & Gales Lane, April 24 3:55 p.m.

An adult male victim reported that he was approached by three male suspects on the footbridge above Route 29. The suspects assaulted the victim and demanded his belongings. The suspects were unable to steal anything and fled. No one was injured. Police responded, located the suspects, and arrested them.
