Opioid overdose

Since the Wed., Dec. 6 daily crime bulletin, police responded to a non-fatal overdose. Naloxone, also known as Narcan, was administered. Narcan is a medication that reverses the effect of an opioid overdose. The person was transported to the hospital for treatment.

2017 YTD Total Overdoses:

Fatal: 53*

Non-Fatal: 158

*In fatal cases, some deaths are pending autopsy results for opioids and/or other substances. Numbers may fluctuate.

Of the 158 non-fatal opioid overdoses, life-saving Narcan was administered in 143 incidents.
