<sup>1</sup>In some cases, deadlines are calculated by law based on the date on which another event or filing occurs. In circumstances where the statute or regulation provides a "deadline" for an event or filing to occur, this calendar will assume that the event occurs on the deadline itself, and will calculate other deadlines based on the date of that occurrence accordingly.

<sup>2</sup>Under Maryland law, if a deadline or date for performing an act is a Saturday, Sunday or State holiday, the deadline is moved to the next regular business day. See EL § 1-301.

<sup>3</sup>COB means close of business. For SBE, the close of business is 5 pm. Because the close of business varies by county, please contact the appropriate local board of elections or circuit court to find out when the office closes.

<sup>4</sup>Most citations refer to the Election Law (EL) Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. COMAR refers to the Code of Maryland Regulations. USC refers to the United States Code.
