Police investigating collision involving motorcycle in West Friendship

Howard County police are investigating a collision in West Friendship involving a motorcycle and one additional vehicle.

Police were called to Route 32 at Old Frederick Road at approximately 7:19 p.m. for a report of a collision.

Through preliminary investigation, police believe a 2003 Yamaha XV1600 motorcycle was traveling southbound on Route 32 when it struck a Honda CR-V crossing 32 on Old Frederick. It appears the Honda had a green light at the time of the collision. The investigation is ongoing.

The operator of the motorcycle, Kenneth Reid Stalcup, 58, was flown to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center with serious injuries.

The driver of the Honda, Sandy Pohyang Kim, 48, and an eight-year-old passenger, were not injured.

Portions of Route 32 were closed at Old Frederick Road for approximately two hours.
