Police seek information on identity of pedestrian struck by train

Police are trying to determine the identity of a man who was struck and killed by a MARC train in Elkridge this morning. Investigators found no wallet or identification for the victim, who appears to be an adult Asian male. Anyone who may have information should contact police at 410-313-3200.

Police were called to the tracks near the 5500 block of Levering Avenue around 6:25 a.m. Preliminarily, investigators believe that the man was walking along the tracks alone when he was struck. No one on-board the train was injured. It is unknown why the man was walking in the area.

Train service is running on a normal schedule, after being delayed for a brief time this morning.
