Police investigating collision involving motorcycle in Clarksville

Howard County police are investigating a collision between a motorcycle and vehicle in Clarksville.

Through preliminary investigation, police believe at approximately 7:46 p.m. on Sunday, a 2015 Ford Mustang was traveling northbound on Route 32 between Route 108 and Linden Church Road when it pulled onto the right shoulder and attempted to make a U-turn. A 2014 Harley-Davidson motorcycle was traveling northbound behind the Mustang and struck the driver's side door.

The two occupants of the motorcycle, both of Woodbine, were ejected and transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center. The driver, Wayne Thomas Duncan, 66, is in stable condition. The passenger, Bonnie Lynn Duncan, 68, is in critical condition.

The driver and sole occupant of the Mustang, Kevin Francis Emblin, 64, of Sykesville, was not injured.

The investigation is ongoing. Charges are pending.

Route 32 between Route 108 and Linden Church Road was closed for approximately two hours.
