

Follow these steps to find your property's Site Development Plan (SDP).

- A. Go to [www.howardcountymd.gov](http://www.howardcountymd.gov).
- B. In the upper right corner of the County homepage, click on GIS Maps. Select Interactive Map in the center of the page. This brings up the appropriate map to find your SDP.
- C. Enter in your address on the upper left side of the page in the "Search Addresses" Bar. As you type, the search engine will populate addresses to the right. When you see your address show up to the right of the search bar, Select It. The Interactive Map will zoom into your property location.
- D. Left of the map are a list of layers accessible to the public. Click on Planning and Zoning. A sub-list of layers will drop down under the Planning and Zoning layer list.
- E. Under the Planning and Zoning layer list, click on the box to the right of "Scanned Drawings" to turn on the layer. This layer may take up to a minute to generate on the Interactive Map.
- F. Once the layer is fully loaded on the map, zoom further into your property. On the map, your property is identified by a red dot.
- G. Click on your property, and a new window should open called Info Tool. In this window, select "Click for Drawing" in the PDF bullet, and a pdf will open for use to view and print.
