Police investigating single-vehicle collision in Ellicott City

Howard County police are investigating a single-vehicle collision in Ellicott City in which two people were seriously injured.

At approximately 7:09 p.m. Saturday, a 2015 McLaren Spider was traveling eastbound on Carroll Mill Road east of Mount Albert Road when it left the roadway for an unknown reason and struck trees.

The driver, 45-year-old Eric Todd Pakulla of Ellicott City, was transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center and is in critical condition. The passenger, 46-year-old Renee Antoinette Jefferson of Ellicott City, was transported to Shock Trauma and is in stable condition.

Police are investigating the cause of the collision. Carroll Mill Road was closed between Folly Quarter Road and Triadelphia Road for approximately two hours.
