ARREST: Robbery update

Police have made three arrests in the Jan. 4 robbery at the Sprint Store in the 11000 block of Resort Road in Ellicott City. Two employees reported that two male suspects with their faces partially covered entered the store, displayed handguns, and stole various items from the store. The suspects also stole the employees' wallets and cell phones before fleeing. No one was injured. Through investigation, police identified the two male suspects and an additional female suspect and arrested them.
