Robbery

An adult male victim reported he was approached by two male suspects on a walking path who demanded his wallet. The victim did not have a wallet, and the suspects stole his eyeglasses and a pair of gloves and fled. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.

SUSPECTS: two black males, both 18-20 years old, one with a short build and wearing a black shirt and gray pants, the other with a tall build and wearing a black shirt and black pants
