**Residential burglary arrest update**

Police have made an arrest in an Aug. 13 burglary in the 8800 block of Red Spruce Way in Jessup. An adult male suspect gained entry to the residence by forcing open the basement glass door and stole a video game console and video games. He fled when a resident yelled from another room. After police posted a surveillance photo of the suspect on social media, the suspect was identified. Police then located and arrested him.

ARRESTED: Tavon Lavar Davis, 26, of West Lombard Street in Baltimore, charged with burglary, theft, and destruction of property

**Theft from vehicle arrest update**

Police have made an arrest in multiple theft cases in which the suspect stole the tires and rims from vehicles. Through investigation, police determined that the suspect stole tires and rims from 12 vehicles in Howard County from June through August. In most cases, the suspect would leave the cars on cinder blocks after stealing the tires and rims. Police also arrested a second suspect who they believe acted as an accomplice.
