**ARREST: Robbery update**

Police have made an arrest in a June 20 robbery at 7-Eleven in the 6500 block of Washington Boulevard in Elkridge. A store employee reported that a male suspect with his face partially covered approached the counter, implied a weapon, and demanded cash. The victim complied and the suspect fled. No one was injured. Through investigation, police identified a suspect and arrested him.
