Opioid overdose

Police responded to two non-fatal opioid overdoses the morning of Nov. 9. Naloxone, also known as Narcan, was administered in both of the overdoses. Narcan is a medication that reverses the effect of an opioid overdose. In both cases, the person was transported to the hospital for treatment.

2017 YTD Total Overdoses:

Fatal*: 47

Non-Fatal: 146

*In fatal cases, some deaths are pending autopsy results for opioids and/or other substances.
Numbers may fluctuate.

Of the 146 non-fatal opioid overdoses, Narcan was administered in 130 incidents.
