**Opioid overdose**

Police responded to a non-fatal overdose this morning in which Naloxone, also known as Narcan, was administered. Narcan is a medication that reverses the effect of an opioid overdose.

2017 YTD Total Overdoses:

Fatal: 55\*

Non-Fatal: 161

Of the 161 non-fatal opioid overdoses, life-saving Narcan was administered in 145 incidents, totaling 90 percent of the cases.

\*In fatal cases, some deaths are pending autopsy results for opioids and/or other substances. Numbers may fluctuate.
