### **UPDATE: Police identify two drivers killed in multi-vehicle collision**

Howard County police are identifying the two drivers who were killed in a multi-vehicle collision that occurred on Route 175 at Route 108 at approximately 12:20 p.m. today.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that a driver of a 2013 Chrysler 200 was traveling westbound on Route 175, just west of Interstate 95, when it sideswiped a vehicle parked on the shoulder of the road. The driver of the Chrysler continued west on Route 175, sideswiped another vehicle that was stopped at a red light, went through the intersection and struck a 2012 Honda Accord that was making a left turn from eastbound Route 175 onto Route 108.

The driver and sole-occupant of the Chrysler has been identified as Lucinda Louise Miller, 67, of Laurel. She was pronounced dead at Howard County General Hospital.

The driver and sole-occupant of the Honda Accord has been identified as Monteia Sherita Carter, 26, of Baltimore. She was pronounced dead at the scene.

There were no other injuries.

Investigators are looking into the possibility that the driver of the Chrysler may have suffered a medical emergency prior to the incident.

Several roadways in the area were closed for approximately four hours. Investigation is continuing.
