Carjacking/abduction

An adult female victim reported that she was at a gas station at the above location when an adult male suspect entered her vehicle, displayed a handgun, and demanded she drive to Baltimore City. The victim complied and once they arrived in the city, the suspect ordered her out of the car and drove off. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing. The vehicle is a 1996 green Toyota Corolla with Maryland tags 1CP2415.
