### **Serious crash shuts down MD-32 east in Jessup**

Howard County police are investigating a serious collision involving three vehicles on MD-32 near Dorsey Run Road in Jessup around 8:15 p.m. One person was transported with life-threatening injuries.

Police were called to the scene after it was preliminarily reported that a car, driven by a lone occupant, rear-ended a second car with two occupants and then sideswiped a third car, which also had two occupants. The details of the collision are still being investigated.

The single-occupant driver was transported to Howard County General Hospital (HCGH) with non-life-threatening injuries. The two occupants in the car that was rear-ended also were transported to HCGH, one with life-threatening injuries, and the other in less serious condition. The two occupants in the sideswiped vehicle were not injured.

The details of the incident, including occupant names, makes and models of the vehicles, and circumstances surrounding the collision are still being confirmed. No citations have been issued at this time.

Eastbound MD-32 will remain closed at Route 1 for an undetermined period of time for the investigation. Additional information will be released as it becomes available.
