### **Police ask for public help to identify Glenelg bank robbery suspect**

Howard County police are asking for the public's help to identify a suspect who robbed the PNC Bank located in the 3900 block of Ten Oaks Road in Glenelg on Jan. 20.

At approximately 10:08 a.m., the suspect entered the bank and approached the teller demanding money. The teller complied and the suspect fled with cash. No one was injured.

The suspect was described as white male in his late twenties, approximately five feet eight inches tall and 200 pounds. The suspect had red facial hair and was wearing a grey hoodie, purple t-shirt, dark-colored jeans and a camouflage hat.

At this time, detectives have not linked this suspect to any other cases. The investigation is ongoing.
