Commercial burglary arrest update

Police have made an arrest in the April burglary of Fort Knox Storage Units in Jessup. Overnight April 27-28, suspects cut the locks off 66 storage units and stole property. Through investigation, detectives identified three suspects involved in the burglary and/or sale of the stolen property.
