ARREST: Carjacking update

Police have made an arrest in a May 6 carjacking in the 8700 block of Cloudleap Court in Columbia. A teenage male victim reported that two male suspects with their faces partially covered approached him as he was sitting in his vehicle, implied a weapon, and demanded he exit the vehicle. The victim complied and the suspects drove off in the vehicle. No one was injured. Through investigation, police identified one suspect and arrested him.
