Robbery

Jessup, 20794: 8000 block of Washington Boulevard, Sept. 28 4:35 a.m.

An adult male victim reported that he arranged to meet an acquaintance at a motel when he was approached by two male suspects in the parking lot. One suspect displayed a gun and they stole the victim's cell phone, jacket, and watch before fleeing. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.

SUSPECTS: two black males, approximately 5'9" with short hair and goatees wearing all black clothing

Three teenage male victims reported that they were approached in a mall parking garage by a male suspect who displayed a gun and demanded their AirPods. The victims complied and the suspect fled. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.

SUSPECT: juvenile black male with curly hair wearing a black hoodie and blue jeans
