Driver injured in overnight collision on Route 32 in Jessup

Police are investigating a single-vehicle collision that occurred overnight in Jessup.

At approximately 1:52 a.m., a 1995 Dodge pickup truck was traveling westbound on Route 32 in the area of Route 1 when it left the roadway for an unknown reason and struck a sign, light pole and guardrail before overturning.

The driver and sole occupant, Nicholas Alan Taylor, 30, of Beltsville, was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center. He is currently stable.

Preliminarily, police are investigating the possibility that speed and alcohol may have been factors in the collision. The driver was not wearing a seatbelt. Charges have not been filed at this time.

Route 32 westbound between Dorsey Run Road and Route 1 was closed for approximately two and a half hours.
