Baltimore man charged in commercial robbery series

Howard County Police have arrested a Baltimore man in connection to a commercial robbery series spanning five years. Calvin Glover, Jr., 29, of Collins Avenue, is charged in a total of eight hotel robberies in Howard County.

Glover's charges include multiple counts of armed robbery, robbery, assault, theft and the use of a firearm in a felony.

On Jan. 7, police were called to the Comfort Suites in the 7100 block of Old Waterloo Road in Elkridge for a report that a suspect had entered the hotel lobby, jumped over the front desk, threatened an employee and stole money from the cash drawer before fleeing.

A suspect with the same description had previously robbed the same hotel on Dec. 29, 2014.

Similar incidents occurred at the Sleep Inn in the 8100 block of Washington Boulevard in Jessup on Nov. 25, 2018, Nov. 21, 2016 and Dec. 2, 2014, the Rodeway Inn in the 5800 block of Bonnie View Lane in Elkridge on Sept. 14, 2018 and Dec. 3, 2014 (then the Econo-Lodge), and the Days Inn in the 9800 block of Washington Boulevard in Laurel on Dec. 2, 2014.

Through investigation, detectives identified Glover as the suspect. In mid-January, he was arrested in a neighboring jurisdiction for a similar crime. Following his arrest, police recovered additional evidence linking him to the most recent Howard County robberies.

Glover is currently being held without bond at the Howard County Detention Center.
