Police investigating fatal collision in Clarksville

Howard County police are investigating a two-vehicle collision in Clarksville in which a woman was killed.

At approximately 12:22 p.m. Monday, a 2017 Nissan Sentra was traveling westbound on Ten Oaks Road approaching Heather Glen Way when it crossed the double yellow line for an unknown reason and collided with a 2013 Ford Expedition traveling eastbound.

The passenger in the Nissan, 23-year-old Deadra Wellington-Brown of Columbia, was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the Nissan, 24-year-old Patrick Ingram Holmes of Columbia, was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The two occupants of the Ford were treated at the scene for minor injuries.

Police are continuing to investigate the cause of the collision.

Ten Oaks Road was closed from Route 108 to the Brighton Dam Road/Ten Oaks Road traffic circle for approximately five hours.
