## **Police investigating Ellicott City collision involving a pedestrian** *Pedestrian transported to Shock Trauma with critical injuries*

Howard County Police are investigating a collision involving a pedestrian with critical injuries in Ellicott City.

At approximately 10:15 p.m., a Fiat 500 was traveling westbound on Baltimore National Pike near N Chatham Road when it struck a pedestrian in the roadway.

The pedestrian, an adult male, was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center with critical injuries.

The driver of the Fiat, a 27-year-old male, and passenger, a 24-year-old male, both of Woodstock, were not injured and remained at the scene. No other vehicles were involved.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the pedestrian was not in a crosswalk at the time of the collision. The investigation is ongoing.

Baltimore National Pike is currently closed between N Chatham Road and Plumtree Drive.
