Police investigating Laurel collision involving pedestrian

UPDATE (Feb. 11, 2016): We are sad to report that the pedestrian struck last night on Route 1 in Laurel, Johnny Ray Wines, 56, has died as a result of his injuries. Police are continuing the investigation and there are no additional updates at this time.

Howard County police are investigating a collision involving a motor vehicle and a pedestrian that occurred at approximately 7:47 p.m. in the 9800 hundred block of Route 1 in Laurel.

A Hyundai Elantra was traveling southbound on Route 1 near Whiskey Bottom Road when a pedestrian, 56-year-old Johnny Ray Wines, entered the roadway and collided with the vehicle. No other vehicles were involved.

Mr. Wines was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center with non-life-threatening injuries.

The driver of the vehicle, Gennadiy Lotkin, 60, and a six-month-old passenger were not injured.

The roadway was closed for approximately one hour while police investigated.
