**Robbery**

**Opioid overdose**

Since yesterday's daily crime bulletin, police responded to a non-fatal overdose. Naloxone, also known as Narcan, was administered. Narcan is a medication that reverses the effect of an opioid overdose.

2017 YTD Total Overdoses:

Fatal: 51\*

Non-Fatal: 152

\*In fatal cases, some deaths are pending autopsy results for opioids and/or other substances. Numbers may fluctuate.

Of the 152 non-fatal opioid overdoses, life-saving Narcan was administered in 138 incidents.
