

Popsicle Stick Train Engine Activity


Use some of those extra popsicle sticks and create your own train engine!

Supplies

- 6-10 popsicle sticks (depends on whether jumbo or regular size)
- Markers
- Construction Paper
- Hot Glue Gun
- Scissors

Instructions

1. Split your popsicle sticks into two equal groups (3 and 3, 4 and 4, 5 and 5 depending on how many you have).
2. Line one group of sticks up next to each other, vertically.
3. Using the hot glue gun, glue the second set of popsicle sticks next to each other horizontally.
4. Color your engine!
5. Using construction paper, cut out 2 wheels and a smoke stack. Glue to the engine.
6. Take another popsicle stick and glue it on top of the wheels.
7. Draw a train engineer and add him to your engine as well!
