Robbery

Columbia, 21045: Kilimanjaro Road & Indian Camp Road, Apr. 27 9:20 p.m.

A teenaged male victim reported he was walking in the area when he was approached by two teenaged male suspects who stole his backpack and fled. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.

SUSPECTS: two teenaged black males, one wearing a white shirt and the other wearing a black shirt

Robbery arrest

Police have made an arrest in a Mar. 26 robbery. An adult male victim who was delivering a pizza in the 6000 block of Majors Lane in Columbia reported he was approached by a male suspect with his face partially covered. The suspect displayed a handgun and demanded cash and the victim's cell phone. The victim complied and the suspect fled. No one was injured. Through investigation, police identified and arrested a 16-year-old suspect who is being charged as an adult.
