### **Detectives arrest seven men in prostitution operation** *Police are posting online “warning ads” to potential suspects*

Howard County police conducted a reverse prostitution operation on Monday, resulting in the arrest of seven men for solicitation of prostitution and related charges.

Officers arrested the men for soliciting prostitution at a hotel in an undisclosed location in Howard County. As part of the operation, detectives placed fake ads on the website backpage, which is a site known to detectives to be used for prostitution. Men who called the number in the ad spoke with an undercover female officer who provided a meeting location upon the caller’s request. When the men arrived and offered money for sex, they were arrested and charged with solicitation of prostitution and disorderly conduct:

- Quintyn Anthony Fraser, 26, of Capitol Heights
- Guillermo Alejandro Saenz Moreno, 20, of Laurel
- Jeffrey Jomo Walker, 49, of Abingdon
- Wesley Karl Watkins, 30, of Severn
- Brandon Michael Williams, 21, of Laurel

This operation is part of Howard County’s ongoing effort to combat prostitution, human trafficking and related offenses.

The HCPD also posts ads on relevant websites reminding people of the dangers and penalties of engaging in this kind of activity. The ads read:

#### **LOOKING FOR A GIRL? POLICE ARE LOOKING FOR YOU.**

HCPD has zero tolerance for Prostitution and Human Trafficking.

If you commit these crimes, you WILL be arrested, prosecuted and your personal information released to the media.

**If you are a victim, HCPD can offer housing, treatment and other help.**
