**Robbery**

Two victims, an adult male and adult female, reported that when they opened the front door to their residence, two suspects with their faces partially covered forced their way in. The suspects displayed handguns, tied the victims' hands, and stole cell phones, watches, cash, and keys before fleeing. No one was injured. Police are investigating to determine if the incident was drug-related. SUSPECTS: two black males in their early 20s, 5'10"-6'0 wearing dark clothing
