**Robbery arrest update**

Police have made arrests in a robbery case.

William Craig Bane, 58, of Audrey Avenue in Brooklyn, was charged with armed robbery, robbery, assault and theft in an Oct. 7 incident in Elkridge. At approximately 9:50 p.m. at the Xtra Mart in the 7300 block of Washington Boulevard, an employee reported that the suspect entered the store, approached the counter, displayed a handgun and demanded money. The employee complied and the suspect fled. No one was injured. Through investigation, police identified the suspect; he was arrested in a neighboring jurisdiction.
