### **Police investigating fatal collision in Ellicott City Sunday Night**

Howard County police are investigating a fatal two-vehicle collision in Ellicott City.

Preliminary, police believe that at approximately 7:55 p.m. Sunday, a 2003 Lincoln Town Car was traveling westbound on Frederick Road past Terra Maria Way when it attempted to pass a 2006 Subaru Impreza on the shoulder. The Town Car swiped the side of the Impreza, left the roadway, and struck a utility pole.

The driver and sole occupant of the Town Car, 30-year-old Dante Taylor of Ellicott City, was transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center where he was pronounced dead. The driver and passenger of the Impreza were treated at the scene for minor injuries.

Police are continuing to investigate the cause of the collision.

Frederick Road at Terra Maria Way remains closed.
