



Community Knitting and Crocheting Volunteer

Brief Description	The volunteer will knit and/or crochet items to donate to HCRP for distribution to a variety of community service projects. The HCRP Recreation Supervisor assigned to the program will supervise group meetings and coordinate donation deliveries.
Duties	The volunteer is expected to attend meetings when possible, knit or crochet items to donate, comply with facility rules and HCRP volunteer regulations, use HCRP yarn for HCRP projects.
Qualifications	To be considered for the volunteer position, the applicant should be dependable, possess good communication skills, and have the ability to work with other volunteers and HCRP staff. Volunteer must also possess a basic knowledge of needlecraft, particularly knitting or crocheting.
