ARREST: Robbery

Police have made an arrest in a July 10 robbery in the 8300 block of Tamar Drive in Columbia. An adult male victim reported that he arranged online to sell a laptop. When he arrived at the agreed upon location, a male suspect entered his vehicle, displayed what appeared to be a handgun, and stole the laptop before fleeing. The victim refused treatment at the scene but went to the hospital at a later time. Through investigation, police identified the suspect and arrested him.
