

AWARD CRITERIA FOR BOTH INDIVIDUAL & ORGANIZATIONAL NOMINATIONS:

Nominees may live or work in Howard County, but their volunteer services must be performed in Howard County. Nominees must demonstrate teachings, work ethic, and the legacy of Dr. King by promoting community involvement among all ethnic groups, regardless of social economic or religious background, and be committed to non-violence and humanitarian services.

Describe the nominee's involvement and type of community participation.

What impact has the nominee had on the community?

How has the nominee's involvement improved or made the community better?

Describe the nominee's measurable contributions and achievements.
