Robbery arrest update

Police have made an arrest in a Feb. 13 armed robbery at the Bank of America in the 5400 block of Harpers Farm Road in Columbia. A bank employee reported that a male suspect with his face partially covered entered the bank, implied a weapon, and demanded cash. The suspect then fled before stealing anything. No one was injured. Through investigation, police identified the suspect and arrested him.
