Police investigating collision involving school bus

Five transported with minor injuries

Howard County police are investigating a collision involving a school bus this morning that resulted in minor injuries.

Preliminarily, police believe that just before 7 a.m., a school bus traveling westbound on Route 100 lost control for an unknown reason as it exited onto Route 29 north. As a result, the bus flipped onto its side. A car traveling northbound on Route 29 struck the bus.

Two adults and two juveniles inside the bus, both 15-year-old students at Mt. Hebron High School, were transported to the hospital as a precaution with minor injuries. The driver of the car was also transported to the hospital with minor injuries.

Route 29 North is closed at this time.
