Police investigating multi-vehicle collision in Mt. Airy

Howard County police are investigating a three-vehicle collision in Mt. Airy in which three people were transported to the hospital.

At approximately 2:23 p.m., a 2013 Ford Expedition was traveling northbound in the 1000 block of Route 27 when it struck the back of a 2007 Toyota Tundra waiting to make a left turn. The Tundra was pushed into the southbound lane of Route 27, where it struck a 2014 Chevrolet Silverado.

The driver and sole occupant of the Expedition, 33-year-old Jennifer Leigh Christian of Woodbine, and the driver and sole occupant of the Tundra, 58-year-old James Gerard Hall of Monrovia, were transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center and are in stable condition. A passenger in the Silverado was transported to Howard County General Hospital with minor injuries.

Police are continuing to investigate the cause of the collision.

Route 27 near Penn Shop Road was closed for approximately three hours.
