


HOSPITAL OPIOID VISITS*






2018 PRESCRIPTION FILLS PER 1000

PREVENTION

Evidence-Based Programming

- **20** Individuals enrolled in Guiding Good Choices Seminar.⁶
- **12** Individuals trained to lead Chronic Pain Management seminars.⁶
- These programs are designed to equip individuals with skills that are shown to reduce substance misuse.

Overdose Response Training

- **831** Individuals trained in Narcan use, improving their ability to intervene in the event of an overdose.⁶

Public Education Campaigns



- Campaign information was distributed through fliers, mall posters, mailers, bus ads, social media postings, and stands given to partner agencies.

TREATMENT/RECOVERY

- **166** PEER recovery connections⁶
- **56** EMS leave-behind Narcan kits dispensed⁶
- **35** HCHD treatment referrals³
- **364** publicly-funded SUD treatment referrals.⁶
- **364** SBIRT (screening, brief intervention & referral to treatment) screenings at Grassroots⁶

ENFORCEMENT/ADJUDICATION

- **87.5%** of overdoses had Narcan administered¹
- **655** SBIRT screenings at Howard County Detention Center⁶
- **7** Drug Court enrollees⁶



COMMUNITY AWARENESS

More than **19 community events** held, including:

- International Overdose Awareness Day, Aug. 31 – approximately 100 participants.
- Howard Community College – approximately 300 nursing students.
- Columbia Association Board of Directors meeting.
