**Robbery**

**Columbia, 21045:** Route 29 & Broken Land Parkway March 10 8:49 p.m.

Two adult victims reported that they were in their vehicle on the shoulder of the road when another vehicle stopped behind them and two male suspects exited. One of the suspects displayed a handgun and stole a wallet, cell phone, and jewelry before fleeing. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.
